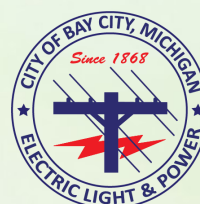

*Polystyrene = cups, egg cartons, takeout containers, packing material, etc. **NO** packing peanuts.

•**Rebates for Recycling:** Rebates for recycling are available for Bay City Electric residential customers. Please bring a copy of your utility bill. The items must be operable and refrigerators must be between 10-30 cubic feet. Limit 2 large and 2 small units per program year. A \$50 rebate per large unit and \$15 rebate per small unit is available on qualifying units. More information regarding appliance recycling can be found at www.BayCityEnergySmart.org.

Tire Disposal:

Passenger car/truck tires only

NO commercial vehicle tires

Limit 10 per resident

Must be off rims and clean

Must present drivers license
